Excluding Package IV, with a casket purchased from our Casket Price List, the following is a listing of packaged services we offer. Packaged services have been discounted. You may order additional services and merchandise. These items may include additional memorial folders, casket, outer burial container, cash advances, etc. We require payment prior to services being rendered. For your convenience, we accept cash, check, and most major credit cards. We also accept verifiable irrevocable insurance assignments processed by us and the remaining balance will go to beneficiaries.

I. Traditional Funeral Service at Mt. Scott Chapel or Church (without procession) \$4,265

This service includes:

- Basic services of the funeral director and staff
- Transfer of remains to funeral home
- Embalming, dressing, other preparations of the remains for viewing
- Use of the facilities and staff for viewing 8am-8pm daily
- Use of the facilities, staff and equipment for service
- Hearse and flower car
- 100 standard memorial folders, acknowledgment cards, and memorial book
- State of Oregon death certificate filing fee

II. Traditional Graveside Service \$4,265

This service includes:

- Basic services of the funeral director and staff
- Transfer of remains to funeral home
- Embalming, dressing, other preparations of the remains for viewing
- Use of the facilities and staff for viewing 8am-8pm daily
- Use of equipment and staff for service
- Hearse and flower car
- 100 standard memorial folders, acknowledgment cards, and memorial book
- State of Oregon death certificate filing fee

III. Traditional Cremation Service \$4,225

This service includes:

- Basic services of the funeral director and staff
- Transfer of remains to funeral home
- Embalming, dressing, other preparations of the remains for viewing
- Use of the facilities and staff for viewing 8am-8pm daily
- Use of the facilities, staff and equipment for service
- Cremation
- Flower car
- 100 standard memorial folders, acknowledgment cards, and memorial book
- State of Oregon death certificate filing fee

NOTE: If service is at a church and we are transporting a casket to church, add \$365.00 for hearse.

- 100 standard memorial folders, acknowledgment cards, and memorial book

The goods and services shown below are those that we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff \$1,645

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.) Staff and facilities to respond to initial requests for service and arrangement conference with responsible party to determine services desired. Coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in final disposition of the deceased. Filing of death certificate and obtaining necessary permits with the Health Department.

Minimum Preparation of Remains \$245

Includes washing and disinfecting of remains.

Embalming \$545

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Our charge for a direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: a proportionate share of basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains; transportation to crematory; necessary authorizations; state filing fee and cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternate container. Alternate containers encase the body and can be made out of materials like fiberboard or composition material (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are cardboard containers.

If you want to arrange a direct burial, you can use an alternate container. Alternate containers encase the body and can be made out of materials like fiberboard or composition material (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are unfinished wood containers.
